TABERNACLE OF DAVID FACT SHEET - MIKE BICKLE

The Tabernacle of David - Mike Bickle

- A. ***The worldwide prayer movement*** - Isaiah 56:5-8; 61:11- 62:1, 6-7; Zech. 8:18-22; 12:10; Amos 9:11-12; Rev. 5: 8; Matt. 21:13. Intercession 24 hour a day - Isa. 62:6-7; 1 Chr. 9:33; Lev. 6:12-14; 24:2-4; Rev. 12: 10; 1 Thes. 3:10; 1 Tim. 5:5; Revelation 5:8; Ps. 134: 1; 135: 1-3.
- B. ***The building of David's tabernacle*** – Amos 9:11-12; Acts 15: 16-17. The 3 dimensions to this restoration. ***A priestly dimension*** – focused on 24 hour a day worship and intercession that follows the Davidic order of worship. ***A prophetic dimension*** – focused on the release of the prophetic ministry in the church of Jesus Christ - Acts 2:17. ***A kingly dimension*** – focused on the apostolic ministry that accomplish the tasks of the kingdom with power fulfilling the Great Commission – evangelism, community and equipping. The Tabernacle of David in all 3 dimensions had its beginning of restoration in the New Testament church. However, the completion of these 3 dimensions **have not yet** been fully restored that the nations might know God. The Tabernacle of David is essential in the completion of the Great Harvest of souls promised to the church at the end of the age. We believe that city wide prayer ministries will fill the earth before the Lord returns.
- C. ***David's Tabernacle is a picture of ministry to God in spirit and truth*** (John 4:24) according to Revelation 4 – 5. The 2 primary activities are seen in Rev. 5: 8. ***The harp*** - speaks of God's songs and God's music in the heavenly court. ***The bowl*** - speaks of God's prayers that are imparted into the heart of the saints.

II. A GENERAL OVERVIEW OF THE TABERNACLE OF DAVID

- A. David in unity with all Israel desired to bring up the ark of God to Jerusalem – 1 Chr. 13:1-8. David built a special tent to house the ark of the covenant.- 1 Chr. 15:1; 16:1.
- B. ***David placed singers and musicians before the ark to minister to God*** - 1 Chr. 6:31-33; 9:33; 15: 16-29; 16:4-7, 42; 23:4-6, 30; 25:1-8; 28:10-21; 29: 4-20. 2 Chr 5:12-14; 7:1-6; 8: 14-15; 9:11; 20:20-22, 28; 23:13; 29:11-36; 30:21; 35:2, 15; 25. Ezr. 2:69-70; 3:10; Neh 11:22-23; 12:44-47. ***Singing and instruments in the prophets*** - Isa. 14:7; 35:2, 10; 38:20; 42:10; 44:23; 48:20; 49:13; 51:11; 54:1; 55:12; Zeph 3:17-19; Ezr. 2:65, 70; 3:10-11; Neh. 12:24, 27-29, 44-47.

- C. **FINANCES** - *From the nations* - 1 Chr 18:11; Ezra 7:12-27. *From David and Israel* - 1 Chronicles 22:14-19; 29:2-5; 2 Chr. 8:12-14; 24:4-12; 29:20-36; 31:4,14, 16; 34:9-17; 2 Kings 12:4-16; 22:3-9; Ezra 1:4; 3:5; 8:23-30; Neh. 11:22-23; 12:47. **David commanded the people to provide finance to release the singers** to minister to God. To free the singers time in order to be devoted to ministry to God. David provided financially for 288 singers- (12 x 24 = 288 - 1 Chr. 25:7). 1 Chr. 9:33; 16:37; 29: 4-20; 2 Chr. 24:9-14; 31:4, 14; Ezra 2:69-70; Neh. 11:23; 12: 45-47.

III. IMPORTANT SCRIPTURES RELATING TO DAVID'S TABERNACLE.

- A. **7 main chapters** that describe the priestly dimension of the Tabernacle of David - 1 Chronicles 13; 15-16; 23; 25; 2 Chr. 29; Neh. 12. Other key chapters relating to the priestly dimension of the Tabernacle of David – **Zech. 4; Hag. 1 -2; Isa. 4; Ps. 132-134; 27; 45; 110; 148-150; 2 Chr. 5-7; 1 Cor. 12-14; Heb. 7- 10; Rev. 4-5;**
- B. **Important single verses** – **Jn.4: 24; Ps. 22:3; 50:2-3; 2 Chr. 20:21-22; Zeph. 3:17; Heb. 2:12; 1 Cor. 12:26; Jn.17:21-26. Key phrase – beauty of holiness – 2 Chr. 20:21; Ps. 29: 2; 96: 9; 1 Chr. 16:29.** The primary source of power is gazing on God's beauty – Ps. 27:4; Isa. 4: 2; 33:17; 6:3; Rev. 4: 8. 1 Chr. 6: 31-33; 9:33; 16: 4-6; 23:1- 5; 25:1-7; 29:1-20; 2 Chr. 8: 14-15; **Jehoshaphat** 2 Chr. 20: 21-22; **Hezekiah** – 2 Chr. 29: 20- 36; **Josiah** - 2 Chr. 34: 9-17 (2 Ki. 22: 3-9), Ezr. 2:69-70; 3:10; Neh. 11: 22-23; 12:44-47; Am. 8:3.

IV. THE TABERNACLE OF DAVID IN HISTORY OF THE KINGS OF ISRAEL

- A. Each time one of the kings of Israel re-instituted the Davidic order of worship in the temple then spiritual break through and military victory came soon afterwards. **8 specific leaders** embraced the Tabernacle of David dimensions of the priestly ministry of David. The 8 specific periods of Israel when the Tabernacle of David was established. **David** – 1 Chr. 15-16 - 1050 B.C. **Solomon** – 2 Chr. 5-7 - 1010 B.C. **Jehoshaphat** -2 Chr. 20 - 896 B.C. **Joash** – 2 Chr. 23-24 – approximately 835 B.C. **Hezekiah** - 2 Chr. 29 – 30 - 726 B.C. **Josiah** - 2 Chr. 35 -623 B.C. **Ezra** – **Ezra 3:10-13** - 536B.C. **Nehemiah** – **Nehemiah 12:28-47** – 446 B.C.
